WAC 192-610-025 Documenting the birth or placement of a child for paid family leave.

- (1) When paid family leave is taken to bond with the employee's child after birth or placement, the department may request, the employee must provide a copy of:
  - (\frac{1}{4}a) The child's birth certificate; or
  - (2b) Certification of birth from a health care provider  $\div$ .
- (2) When paid family leave is taken to bond with the employee's child after a child's placement as defined in WAC 192-500-190, the employee must provide a copy of
- (3) C a court documents to show order verifying placement.

  If a court order is not available, the department may accept

  alternate documentation sufficient to verify the placement; or.
- (43) Other reasonable Additional documentation may be requested to substantiate the qualifying event.
